# **On to the news. Protests at Forest Grove flagpole grow over Trump, Musk, and Ukraine**



At least two protests in Forest Grove in February have drawn increasingly larger groups of people to the flagpole protesting President Donald Trump's administration, Ukraine policies, and tech billionaire Elon Musk's influence in the federal government.

A small protest held Feb. 15 drew around 20 people to what has become <u>a common protest spot</u> in Forest Grove: the giant flagpole east of Safeway at the triangle formed by the start of Forest Grove's one-way grid.

A significantly larger crowd gathered at the flagpole on Friday, Feb. 28. Nearly 50 people joined a protest in response to President Donald Trump's policies on the Russo-Ukrainian War.
